Precaution for Seto-Ohashi Bridges Sky Tour

Please keep in mind the following items if you participate in the tour.

- Smoking and drinking are not permitted during the tour.
- We do not have the storage room so that please bring only minimum amount of unnecessary baggage.
- Please keep your wallets and other valuables in the pockets of your clothes during the tour.
- You may bring your own plastic bottle or water bottle for hydration if necessary. In this case, you may bring your own pouch or other container to wear, depending on the size of the bottle you wish to bring, or the Sky Tour office can provide you with a semi-fitted pouch or other similar item for loan.

(In case of a large number of participants, the loan of equipment may be arranged on a group basis.)

- In principle, each participant is requested to bring only one piece of equipment for photography (digital camera, smartphone, etc.) in order to prevent falling objects. Please hang your equipment by a strap or other means from your head. In this case, please bring your own strap or the Sky Tour Office can lend you one. The same applies to straps to prevent glasses from falling off.
- The tour guide will explain where to drink water and where to take photos.
- In the tour, an elevator is used to reach the top of the tower. However, due to the number of participants and EV capacity on the day of the event, there may be cases where the number of groups is split. We ask for your understanding in this matter. The elevator will take from 1 minute to 1 minute and 20 seconds.
- If a guest is not feeling well during the tour, the tour guide will do his/her best to provide first aid to the person in question. In such cases, if the tour is not completed as a result, the tour guide and the tour sponsor, Honshu-Shikoku Bridge Expressway Company Limited, will discuss and deal with the situation afterwards.

• Because Covid-19 has been reclassified as Class 5, whose guidelines are less binding than previous ones, since May 8, 2023, we have finished some preventive measures for infection and a request of wearing a mask. However, we ask for your continued cooperation with preventing the spread of infection by refraining from joining a tour if you are not feeling well etc.
